09:45hrs. Arrive at **Doi Tung Development Project (DTDP)**

10:00hrs. Brief explanation about Doi Tung and the Doi Tung Development Project (DTDP), one of flagship projects of the Mae Fah Luang (Queen Mother) Foundation Venue: Doi Tung Café in the Mae Fah Luang garden (TBC)

Speaker: Ms.Amornrat Bungkomneth, Knowledge Dissemination Manager, who has been working with the foundation for more than 20 year.

10:30hrs. Visit Cottage Industry Centre and Outlet

This mid-stream phase of development combines the wisdom and skills of traditional weaving and embroidery by local women with modern techniques and designs to create unique value-added handicrafts highly desired in domestic and international markets.

The tour includes visits to:

- Weaving factory
- Mulberry paper factory
- Coffee roasting facility
- Ceramics factory

- Visit the Coffee Roasting Facility. Learn about Doi Tung coffee from farm to cup, with coffee tasting

Speaker: Ms.Kamnual Nansai, Representing young Shan women of Doi Tung. Kamnual has been trained by DTDP to be one of our coffee roasting experts.

- Visit the Ceramic factory. The factory started when DTDP replaced plastic bags used for tree seedlings with biodegradable pots of clay and vetiver grass for its reforestation program. The project later converted the factory to produce quality ceramics, training people in new skills, generating jobs and income for Doi Tung villagers. D.I.Y.activities

Speaker: Ms.Tippawan Daungdokmoon. Trained by DTDP, this young art lover has become a highly skilled worker working closely with MFLF designers.

- Visit the Mulberry paper factory. The factory reflects the harmony of life with the forests, with sustainable use of forest projects. D.I.Y.activities

Speaker: Ms.Sao Nansaeng. Trained on the job, this Shan woman is now Quality Control Supervisor for the Mulberry paper factory.

- Visit the weaving factory. Combining Local wisdom with modern techniques and design, the weaving factory has generated jobs and incomes for 3 generations of Doi Tung women. Shopping at Doi Tung outlet.

Speaker: Ms.Kam Takumjing. This elder Shan woman is one of first and best weavers of Doi Tung, having joined factory since its start.

- Visit Navuti Company coffee and macadamia plantation Site 1, and value-added processing factory. A journey of Doi Tung coffee and macadamia and coffee cherry picking activities. *(Founded in 1989, Navuti is one of the first public-private partnerships and Social Enterprises in Thailand.)*

Speaker: Mr. Luang Namyee. Coffee farm support supervisor, who ensure Doi Tung coffee is of high quality from farm to processing facility



14:45hrs.

- Visit the Mae Fah Luang Arboretum at Doi Chang Moob.

(Situated along the Nang Non Range, The Chang Moob peak is 1,500 metres above sea level. It has a cool climate year-round, which made it suitable for opium cultivation. Once the largest opium field and center of a major drug trafficking route in the area, Chang Moob is now site of and arboretum with thousands of unique temperate plants.

Speaker: Mr. Tawatchai Yaibua. Plant, flower and bird expert
