Tumon Bay is Guam's tourism and economic hub, home to luxury stores, nightclubs and one of the longest tunnel aquariums in the world. At the northernmost tip of Guam is Ritidian Point, a national wildlife refuge and the site of one of the island's most pristine sandy beaches. Two Lovers Point - a startling cliff line in Northern Guam - overlooks the glimmering Philippine Sea and is the setting of an ancient Chamorro legend.

Visa Requirements

In general, citizens of most other countries must have a valid passport with a US visa. Delegates requiring a US visa are recommended to apply for a tourist visa for attending PAS 2016. Entry requirements for Guam are the same as for any US destination. It is recommended that US citizens travel to Guam with their passports.
