Undeveloped beach paradises, a startlingly rich cultural heritage, a wide variety of wildlife and adventure experiences, as well as warmly welcoming people and irresistible cuisine - but minus the tourist hordes - makes Sri Lanka a tropical utopia for the discerning traveller.

Located close to the Bandaranaike International Airport, Negombo is a seafood lover's realm with fresh catches available at a diverse selection of restaurant and bars. Alternatively, take a boat ride along the Dutch canals or into the ocean to catch a glimpse of the fishing boats. Negombo was one of the most important sources of cinnamon during the Dutch era, and European influences still remain.

PLAN YOUR VISIT

Visa Requirements

Electronic Visa (ETA) can be obtained prior to arrival through the Electronic Travel Authorisation System at www.eta.gov.lk or on arrival at the port of entry. Visa is valid for two entries within a 30-day period but may be extended up to 90 days from the date of arrival at the first instance and further 90 days at the second instance. On the basis of reciprocity, citizens of the Republic of Singapore, the Republic of Maldives and the Republic of Seychelles are exempt from the requirement of obtaining ETA to visit Sri Lanka. Diplomatic and Official passport holders are exempt from ETA processing fee only when their applications are submitted through state agencies such as Ministries, Statutory Bodies, Sri Lanka Overseas Missions etc.

Airport Transfers
