

• PATA Tour # 06 : Hill County Tour (01 night / 02 days)

Day 1

Early morning proceed to Kandy

Kandy was the last capital of the Sri Lankan kings and is a world heritage site. The name Kandy conjures vision of splendor and magnificence. Many of the legends, traditions and folklore are still lovingly kept alive. Drive around the Kandy Lake built by the last Sinhala king Sri Wickrama Rajasinghe in 1798. Do a short city tour of Kandy, Visit the Temple of tooth relic and proceed to Nuwara Eliya.



Nuwara Eliya – Sri Lanka's premier hill resort with a fine bracing mountain climate, NuwaraEliya is also the heart of Sri Lanka's tea country, producing some of the world's best tea. The mountain slopes and valleys are a carpet of velvety green tea plantations, interspersed with gushing streams and tumbling waterfalls. Red or green roofed plantation bungalows, English country style homes and hotels with lovely flower gardens, a fine 18 hole golf course and a racecourse gives Nuwara Eliya a decidedly British character.



Overnight stay at a star class hotel on Bed and Breakfast basis in Nuwara Eliya.

Day 2

After breakfast visit the Hakgala Botanical Gardens, this is situated south of Nuwaraeliya which was established in 1860. Beyond Hakgala lies Horton Plains, a windswept plateau over 2000 meters high. These misty, silent grasslands streaked with icy rivulets, offer some excellent walks, the most famous being to World's End, a 4km Hike.



On completion proceed to Colombo, Negambo or Airport.
