Local Way of Pattaya Rice Farmer Program Nongprue - Nong Palai Community

<u>09.00 – 12.00 hrs.</u> Visit Nong Palai Community

- Welcoming with Thai folk dance (by Sawangsilp local band)
- Learning the way of life of Thai farmer how to gathering and thrashing Thai Hom Mali rice
- Demonstration how to do Thai pounded unripe rice (Kaow Mao) and cooking coconut pudding (Khanom Krok)







12.15 – 13.15 hrs. Lunch (Thai local cuisine)

13.15 – 15.30 hrs. Visit Wat Nong Prue

- Wat Nongprue which has been the ancient temple in Baan Nongprue for over hundreds of year. It was established on the plain covering with elephant grass (Cattail). In the past, the locals had to walk pass elephant grasses and swamps in order to go to the temple.







- Wat Nong Prue Monastery Museum which exhibit the golden teak, including antiques collected as historical evidence and references by the abbot for the educational purpose.
- Showing Khon performance and learning Thai Traditional masked play (Khon) by Nong Prue Community. The Khon is a traditional Thai dance drama which includes part masked dance and part play. Originally the Khon was performed at the royal court.
- Visitors also have the opportunity to learn experience as follows:







- 1) Painting mini Khon mask
- 2) Learning how to dance Khon
- 3) Wearing Thai traditional loincloth
